Caring Instructions for your Human Hair Wig

• Pin wig tightly to wig head, leaving no loose pockets yet making sure not to tear or stretch the net and brush hair with a wide toothcomb or a vent brush working your way from the bottom upwards.

• Rinse with lukewarm water.

• Apply color safe shampoo throughout the wig. You can dilute the shampoo in a cup of water and evenly disperse.

• Rinse well and repeat if a nice healthy lather is not achieved.

• Condition the wig staying away from the roots. Allow conditioner to set in for a couple of minutes.

• Rinse thoroughly especially by the nape area where shampoo and conditioner tend to accumulate.

• Wrap the wig in a towel and squeeze excess water out without agitating the hair.

• Comb the wig, with wide toothcomb, starting from the bottom working your way up.

*Permed Wigs should not be brushed. It will cause the hairs to frizz. With your hands just bunch up the hair to get it back into shape.

♦ It is best to let the wig air dry and style the wig when it is slightly damp.

• When considering a color treatment, highlight or any chemical service you would always have the stylist perform a patch test on a small inconspicuous section in the back.

*Blow-dryer and hot rollers can be used just as on your own natural hair, making sure not to overheat the wig and heat should keep moving constantly so not to singe.
